<p>Shark Tank</p>	<p>Introduction to start-up creation. Covering basic concepts, working methods, strategies, gathering, understanding and presenting information, this program gives a sense of satisfaction and achievement to young student entrepreneurs who will follow the entrepreneurial path, including welcoming strategists, success stories and... failures.</p> <p>The program is tailored to the project's students wish to develop, through which they experience all the stages of startup development: problem, idea, research, solution, Go2Market, MVP, Prototype, PoC and face the challenges of realization, marketing. The course covers strategy, tactics, sales, contracts, technology, capital raising, team management and leadership.</p> <p>The course provides strategies, tactics and business, managerial and economic tools used by the entrepreneur and their application in everyday life. At the end of the year, a hackathon is organized, enabling students to present their product to an expert jury.</p>
<p>Diplomacy in Action</p>	<p>The "Diplomacy in Action" program covers foreign policy strategies, the structures of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and encompasses the variety of a diplomat's roles abroad, tasks, roles, experiences and challenges. The course teaches strategies, tactics and the business, management and intelligence tools used by the diplomat, as well as their application in everyday life. The</p>



	course includes the use and practice of real diplomatic events.
Foreign Affairs & Advocacy	During the course, students are trained in advocacy activities, particularly through social networks, to do advocacy challenges of the State of Israel, the Arab boycott, terrorist incidents and to influence world public opinion through positive diplomacy. The main product will be a presentation of the work to the Minister of Information of the State of Israel.
Model UN	<p>A program designed to expose students to different countries and cultures, strengthen relationships between students and their peers from other countries, understand the common denominators between children from all over the world, and experience working, debating, persuading and influencing at the various United Nations conferences.</p> <p>We will also organize a unique festive event during which we will set up a complex with national stands for each country. Students will come dressed in traditional clothing, including national dishes and typical household utensils. The fair will be held in cooperation with the relevant embassies and expatriates of various faiths.</p>
Young Knesset	Introduction to the working model of the Knesset in its committees and plenary, knowledge of the national structure, the separation of authorities and the management of debates on topical issues. Students will meet judges and visit the Knesset.
Youth Leadership Program	Designed to develop leadership skills and direct processes by students, accepting and assuming responsibility, as well as leveraging teams and proactivity. Participants will receive a box of management and leadership strategies and tools for lifelong use. Some content has been built on material from IDF cadet courses, flight school and business administration.
